✓ **What we're learning:**

Language Arts: In language arts we have finished working on both short 'i' and short 'o' words as well as lots of work with consonant work. We are learning to edit and fix our writing in Writer's Workshop as well as making title pages like real authors!

Math: In math we've covered many areas. We've learned to read graphs as well as creating our own, we've learned our ordinal numbers, we've learned to measure in centimeters and inches, and we've just started working with $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, and $\frac{1}{4}$ fractions.

Centers/Guided Reading: The students get to read everyday in guided reading with either me, or Mrs. Cherry. The students really enjoy this time. We work on all sorts of reading strategies to help their reading process.

Religion: In religion we've learned about many things including, The Holy Trinity, The Holy Family, the Shepard and the sheep, and we've just recently learned the two parts to the bible.

Social Studies: In social studies we've learned about factories, buying and selling goods, needs and wants, and we've just recently started learning about the past, present and future.
